Mr. Best: What have you got to say, Bev?

SCENE 2

WOODS

Marjorie: Did you hear what happened in school today? Maybe it's because of that.

Evelyn: What happened?

Marjorie: Renee and Vicky were syaing that Killer killed one of Renee's chickens. And Bev came home all upset.

Evelyn: Oh, no!

Marjorie: Yes, and Renee said if Hooker saw our dog up there anymore he's going to shoot him.

SCENE 3

<u>1ST PUBLIC MEETING</u> (People start to enter)

Mr. Best: Hello, Hooker.

Hooker: Sir.

Mr. Best: Could everyone please take their seats. (Everyone sits down) As principal of the school I thought I'd better call this meeting tonight. Some people in Mud Lake think Marjorie's dog killed Donna and Hooker's chicken. We can't have a dog running loose in the community. It can lead to trouble. Does anyone have, any comments?

Donna: Well, all I know is that when I went to check the chicken coop this morning there was feathers all over the place and one of my chickens was dead.

Marjorie: I don't know why you people are blaming me and my dog. Killer is not the only dog in Mud Lake. And Jordan Hope did tell my brother Randy that he saw a wolf up Whitefish.

Duffy: When I went up Hooker's store last night to buy some cigarettes, I saw Killer out by the chicken coop. He could have killed the chicken.

Hooker: We can't have a dog killing our chickens. Chickens cost a lot of money - not to mention all the time it takes to take care of them - Right, Donna?

Evelyn: I know chickens are expensive Hooker. But you're not the only one to consider here. Think about Marjorie. Everyone's accusing her dog and we don't know for sure if was Killer or not.

SCENE 4

(Bev goes to turn on tape)

(Students dance around room, mock, singing, etc.)

Bev: Did you hurt yourself? (stops dancing) Look athte guys! (points) (Goes and turns down tape)

SCENE 5

(Everyone rushes to teacher)

Donna: Me, too.

Mr. Best: I know you're all angry but I think we can settle this matter together. Please have a seat. (Everyone sits) We will try to come up with a peaceful settlement.

(Hooker enters)

Hooker: This is the only way to settle it - with a gun!

Donna: Calm down, now Hooker dear!

Marjorie: I don't know why you want to kill my dog. Killer is innocent!

Donna: Your dog had our children terrorized at the school wake-a-thon last night.

Evelyn: Yes! Bob you were chaperoning our kids last night. Why don't you tell us what happened?

Marjorie: Yes, please do - I've heard a dozen different stories aobut what happened last night and you know how kids exaggerate.

Mr. Best: Well, two of the children went outside for some fresh air - they came running in all frightened. I calmed them down and went out to check the situation.

Duffy: What did you find?
