have another joke for you."

Everyone- "Take your time Harold."

Henry- "Did you hear about the two Nova Scotians..."

Lawrence- "That is a sick joke."

(Harold laughs and falls to the floor.)

Rick- "Harold laughs at anything."

Brian- "Go check him Henry, he's your brother"

Henry- "He's not breathing"

Lawrence- "Call 911."
