Tommy: Yeah, I guess you're right.

I heard Mom say that the bus was going to be late, so let's start walking. Andrew:

**SCENE III -** Classroom. They are late.

Tommy:

I think we made it!

Andrew:

Or not!

Mrs. E:

Boys, you're late!

Andrew:

The buses were behind schedule so we decided to walk.

Mrs. E:

They still got here before you did.

Andrew & Tommy:

Yes Mrs. Ellsworth. (Rolls eyes)

Mrs. E:

SCENE IV - On the playground. Andrew and Damien get in a fight. Tommy is on the playground waiting for Andrew to join him.

Tommy:

Great, time for lunch! But where's Andrew?

Damien:

Hey dork, where's your lunch? I'm getting hungry.

Andrew:

(enters scene) Leave him alone y-y-you jerk!

Damien:

You're askin for it ain't you dweeb?

Andrew:

I just don't want you stealing our lunches.

(Andrew and Damien get into a huge fight. Unfortunately it attracts the attention of their teacher, Mrs. Ellsworth.)

Mrs. E:

(very angry) Stop fighting right now! You all just march yourselves right into the principal's office!

**SCENE V** - In the principal's office. Boys get suspended

Mrs. Carson: Okay guys. Come in. (Boys walk in) Okay boys, why are you here? (Boys start yelling all at once) hey, hey, hey quiet down. One at a time. Tommy, you first.

Tommy:

Well.....I was..I was......

Andrew: Damien was picking on Tommy so I gave him what he deserved.

Damien: Yeah, if I saw you coming with that sucker punch I would have killed you.

Andrew: Oh yeah?

Damien: Yeah!

you.

SCENE VII - Tommy is walking home and overhears Damien's parents through their window

Laura:

Stop, stop Ron.

Ron:

You don't tell me when to stop! He deserves this beating for being suspended for the second time this week. He's a disgrace. I am ashamed to be your father. You

were just a mistake!

Laura:

Ron! The neighbours might hear! Stop!

Ron:

Shut the window then!

Tommy:

Holy cow! Poor Damien! (Spends the rest of the day thinking about Damien)

### **SCENE VIII**

Tommy:

(Talking to his bear Snuggles) Oh Snuggles, I don't know what to do! Damien might not want me to tell. I just don't know. If I do tell, he might get beaten again. Or they might take him away from his parents. What's the right thing to do?

Ms W:

Tommy, time for supper!

Tommy:

Coming!!!

**SCENE IX** - The Wilkinson home. Morning

Ms W:

Tommy wake up.

Tommy:

I'm already up.

Ms W:

Come downstairs now. The bus will be here in fifteen minutes.

Tommy:

(enters kitchen. Mother has another breakfast carefully prepared) Eggs, bacon

and toast mmmm.

Ms W:

Hurry up and eat Tommy.

Tommy:

I'm hurrying, I'm hurrying!

Emily: Bye Tommy! (Sticks out tongue)

**SCENE X -** At the bus stop. Tommy talks to Andrew

Andrew: Hey Tommy! Tommy!

Tommy: Huh? What? Sorry.

Andrew: Something bothering you Tommy?

Tommy: Yes. I have something on my mind.

Andrew: Spit it out! What are friends for?

Tommy: I don't know what friends are for! But you'll probably find out after school.

## **SCENE XI**

Tommy: I passed by your house and I sorta heard your dad.......

Damien: SHUT UP! DON'T...... IF YOU EVER TELL ANYONE I WILL...... (leaves

in a fit of rage. Andrew walks in)

Andrew: Hey Tommy! What did you just say to Damien? Man, is he ever mad! Come on,

let's go.

Tommy: You go on. I got to go see the principal.

Andrew: OK

**SCENE XII** - In the principal's office. Tommy decides to go and have a talk with Mrs. Carson about Damien and how he is getting abused at home.

Mrs. Carson: Hello Tommy. How can I help you?

Mrs. E: Tommy, Andrew said you were here, is everything all right?

Tommy: Um, I don't know if I should be here, but I think maybe this is the right thing to

do. I'm just going to say how I first found out about Damien's parents. I was walking past his house and the window was opened. I heard Damien's parents

fighting because his dad was beating him.

Mrs. E: Beating is abuse, Tommy. It's the school's job to report this to the police. This is

a very serious situation. This explains why Damien is such a bully. Usually kids

that bully have problems at home or at school.

Mrs. Carson: I want you to go back to class and let us handle this.

(Police drive away and Tommy returns home)

SCENE XIV - kitchen

Tommy: Mom guess what? The cops took Damien away from his dad because he was

beating him but they only found out because I ratted on him and......

Mrs. W: Slow down.

Tommy: Okay, Damien had been beaten by his dad. I found out when I saw it through the

window. I told the teachers about it and they said they would report it to the

police.

Mrs. W: Poor Damien. The laws on child abuse are very strict these days, He may never be

able to see his dad again. I don't know if he would want to see him again.

Tommy: Oh no, what have I done? Poor Damien.

Mrs. W: Tommy, you didn't do the wrong thing. If anything you did the right thing.

Tommy: Mom, could Damien stay with us? Just for a few days? I really feel I owe it to

him. He probably would have preferred if I hadn't told at all.

Laura: This is stupid. I don't want to be here. How could you help anyway?

Cynthia: I know how you are feeling but talking it out often helps.

Laura: I don't see how, but if you really want to listen.

Cynthia: Come into my office. No one will bother us there. So start....start at the

beginning.

Laura; Well, I am here because my husband was arrested.

Cynthia: Has this ever happened before?

Laura: No...... (starts to cry)

Cynthia: It's okay.

Laura: Well, it seems to always happen when I am picking up for my son. My husband

thinks I should be on his side.

Cynthia: Does this happen often?
