(In hospital - doctor, nurse and patient)

Doctor: All right then nurse, what do we have here?

(Mom leaves to the basement and in walks Karen)

Karen: Good.

Dad: Glad to hear it. You heading home now?

Karen: Yep, Mom wants to get pictures and stuff and Mark is picking me up over there.

Karen: Ok, see ya. (Walks out the door. Dad starts flicking through the channels, Mom starts

mumbling as she enters)

(Hailey and Mom enter. Mike stands up quickly and stares in awe)

Mike: Hailey...you look...beautiful.

Hailey: (Blushing) Thanks, you look really hot...uh...I mean handsome.

Mike: Let's get going then. We don't want to be late.

Mom: Oh wait, let me get a picture! (Places the kids, then snaps a picture) Oh that's perfect.

Ok then, off you go!

Hailey: Bye Mom, bye Dad, I love you.

(Hailey and Mike exit. Mom and Dad left)

Mom: Oh Danny, wasn't it just yesterday we were bringing her home?

Dad: Molly you said that at her kindergarten graduation too. (Laughs) Our little girl is all

grown up.

(Lights go up on ER doctor and nurse)

Doctor: Sponge Nurse! Pass me those artery clamps! How are her stats?

Nurse: Here you go doctor, 96/60BPM and dropping! Brain activity minimal. But staying

constant.

(Light fades and comes up at the after party at Josh's house)

Mike: And then I was like, yeah right, Mr. Flynn, like you even know the lyrics to the

Stones, let alone played with them! (Everyone starts laughing)

Josh: Ah man, Mike, that was an awesome class! You totally burned him!

Mike: Yeah, it was pretty cool.

Party Guest 1:Tell us another one Mike.

Party Guest 2: Yeah Mike, here have another drink.

Mike: I really shouldn't, I'm supposed to drive Hailey home later.

Party Guest 2:C'mon man, what's one little drink gonna do! Here...

Mike: Ok but just one.

(Lights to ER again)

Nurse: Doctor! Her heart rate is dropping! 90. 84,79, 76

Doctor: She is going into cardiac arrest! Start the defibrillator!

Nurse: Defibrillator ready

Doctor: Ready...go! (Pushes two metal plates down on chest, body jumps)

(Light fades back to party. Mike enters with some friends, kind of tipsy but not as bad as his friends)

Mike: Oh man, I'm gonna miss you guys next year.

Josh: I'm gonna miss you too Mike...and you! (Looks at the party guy next to him)

(Hailey enters sober and a bit angry)

Hailey: MIKE! Are you drunk?

Mike: No way Hailey. I just had a few drinks.

Hailey: A few! You're supposed to drive me home later. You can't drive like that!

Mike: C'mon Hailey. Who's it gonna hurt to have a few drinks? Wait half an hour. I'll drink

some coffee and then we can go...

Hailey: I dunno Mike...

Mike: Trust me Hailey. I don't even feel anything.

Hailey: (sighs) OK...

Mike: Thanks Hailey. I love you!

Hailey: I love you too Mike...

Josh: I love you too Mike!

(Lights on ER room again)

Nurse: She's flat lining Doctor.

Doctor: Get me the epi STAT! I can't lose her!

Nurse: Here!

Doctor: Come on, come on!

Nurse: She's gone...

Doctor: Note the time of death. I'll go speak to the parents.

Nurse: Time of death 12:01 AM. Her parents are in the waiting room...The Donavons.

Doctor: OK Thanks. Get her cleaned up so they can come in and see her.

(Waiting room. There is the mom and dad)

Mom: Oh my God Danny, this can't be happening! Our baby can't be in there...

Dad: Don't worry Molly, she'll be fine with all the technology of today. She has to be

fine...she has to...

(Enter Mike and a police officer)

Mom: What were you thinking Mike?

Mike: It wasn't my fault! I never saw the truck coming!

Dad: Stop it! Blaming each other won't make anything any better.

(Doctor enters)

Mom: Oh my! Doctor, tell me, is my baby ok? She's alright isn't she? (Crying and in heaps

of breath)

Doctor: I'm sorry Mr. And Mrs. Donavon, we did the best we could.

Mom: NO! (Falls to the floor, tears, screaming "It can't be true") Danny, our little girl, our

(Danny doesn't reply. He is too shocked)

(They enter the room where Hailey lays)

ready.

(Doctor leaves Mom and Dad alone with the body)
